

Lack of Safety can get you in Jail

As narrated by Mr Santosh Tekawade owner Santosh Sales to Mr. Ajit Panicker President RATA

Safety of air-conditioning technicians working at site and at workshops has been a low priority issue at most small and medium sized enterprises and this story is from a trade member Mr. Santosh Tekawade of Santosh Sales, Mumbai. At RATA we are focused to bring an awareness on this area of our business. Safety has to be a priority and has to be thought through at all times. We thank Mr. Santosh for taking the first step in sharing his experiences, lets this be a learning for all of us in trade in revisiting the safety measures for our employees.

This incident happened sometime in 2015 when Santosh was out of Mumbai in Pune on a Saturday weekend, when he received a call at 7.30pm from his office that his Technician Yadav had met with an accident at site. The service Manager at Santosh Sales had called the technician Mr. Yadav who has been their employee for over 6 years to attend a split air conditioner complaint at Juhu in the evening, Yadav was sent to site with a trainee apprentice as his helper. To identify the problem the technician stepped out near the outdoor, the electricity to the unit was not cut off and a live wire that Yadav held proved fatal and he was electrocuted. The apprentice was helpless while all of this happened and out of fear left the site. The technician was brought to the hospital where he was declared dead on arrival. It was evident that the technician had not followed safety measures before checking the split air conditioner and that negligence cost him his life.

The following day not only had Mr. Santosh lost one of his men but his ordeal began with the authorities and the victims family. The family refused to accept the victim's body till Mr. Santosh arrived. On his arrival the following day at the police station the victims family and local corporator created a huge amount of ruckus that got Mr. Santosh arrested. It soon became evident that this was becoming a money extortion game. Mr. Santosh offered to help with the only condition being a monetary compensation package in the name of the technicians wife and a lifelong job to Yadavs wife at his company. However that was not acceptable to the victims family. Mr. Santosh though arrested was out post his bail, till then the police also took into custody his service manager and the customer where Yadav had gone to attend the complaint. They were charged under Section 304-A- (Causing death by negligence. *Whoever causes the death of any person by doing any rash or negligent act not amounting to culpable homicide, shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to two years, or with fine, or with both.])

The Police investigated all the employment conditions at Santosh Sales and there were no violations of the law as Santosh Sales had followed all compliances related to ESIC, checked the technical capability of the technician before hiring him, the technical certificates of the employee, safety equipment given to employees like the gloves, safety belts, shoes and tools. The important discovery in these investigation was that Yadav worked as a technician during the day and rode his fathers auto rickshaw in the night. Yadav lived separately and is survived with his wife and a child. Continued on Pg. 8

Lack of Safety can get you in Jail

- Mr. Santosh Tekawade continues to fight this case in the courts costing him lakhs every year, he has made some changes post this incident at his company which is a learning for all of us.
- 1. Safety is the No. 1 priority of his company, every safety equipment and practices are reviewed every six months and an employee signature is taken as confirmation that he has been trained and will adhere to all sites.
- 2. Everyday 8.30 am to 9.30 am is a safety training session in his company and every technician has to attend to the same conducted by his service Manager.
- 3. Santosh Sales has taken an accidental Insurance policy for all his employees.
- 4. All matters related to labor compliances are strictly adhered and reviewed every month.

During this entire discussion with Mr. Santosh Tekawade one thing that stood out was when he told me, that all his life his company has won many sales awards for exceptional achievement almost every year, he seems to have forgotten all of those recognitions when he has to live with the reality that one of his team members lost his life because of lack of safety.


